Gotham Gazette: Desperately Needed Infrastructure Improvements Must Be Given Dedicated Funding

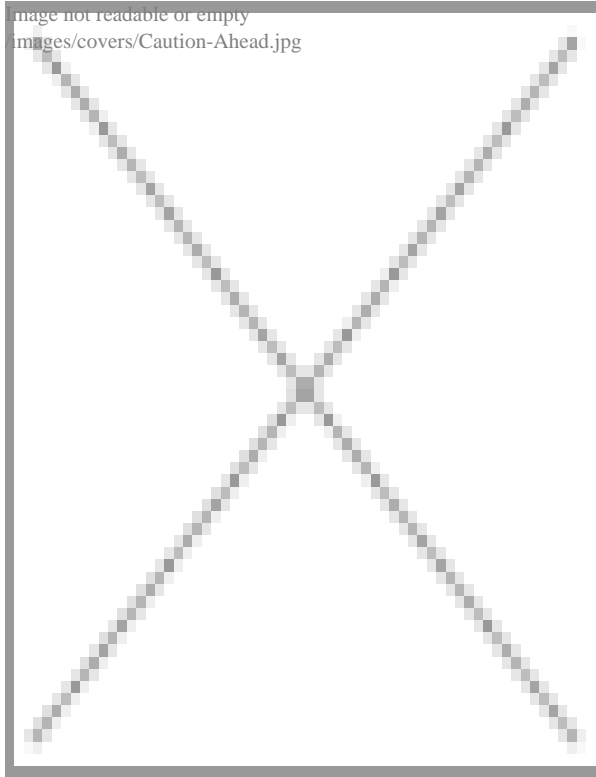
