New York remains a global center for law firms, but employment in the city's legal services sector is down 3 percent over the past two decades.

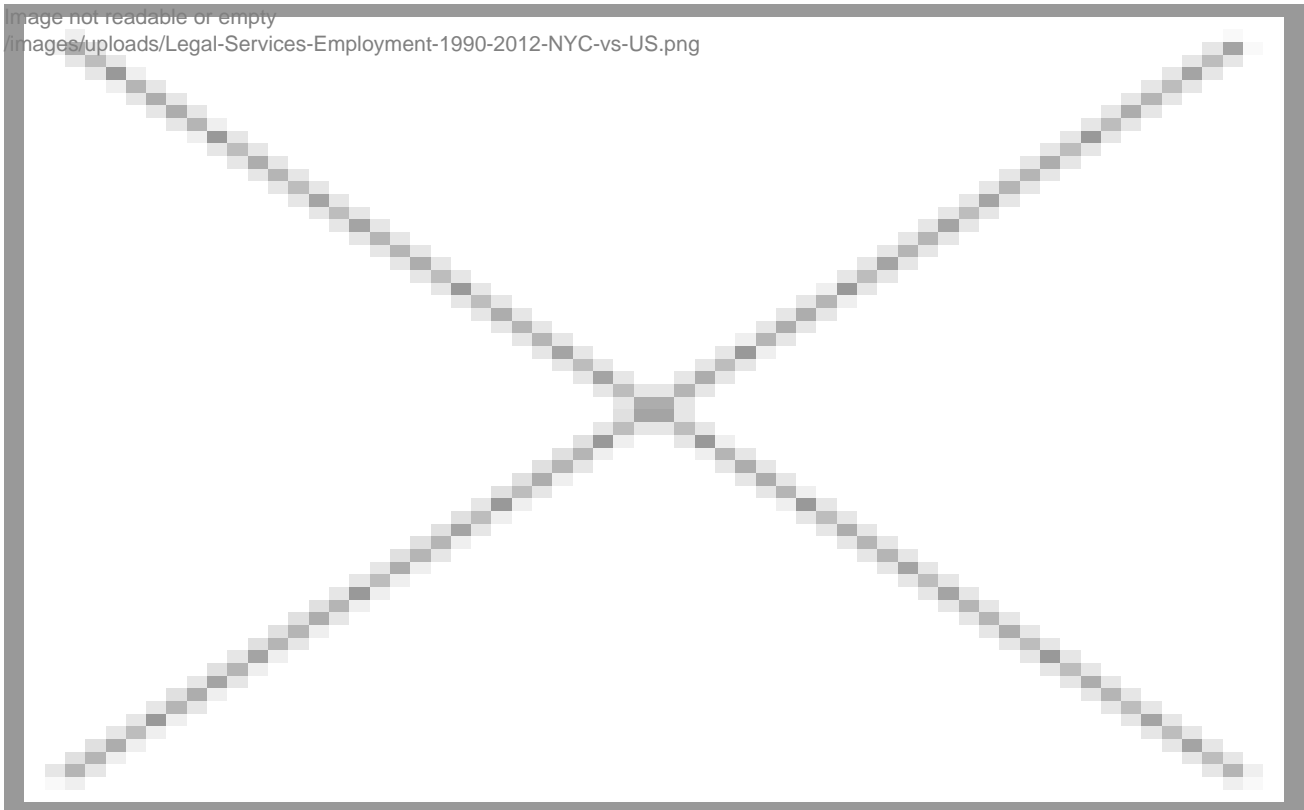
